Following that we need to submit a proposal to DFID for the balance of the funding and they are expecting this proposal.
	Cr L Jaques advised he will be meeting with DFID next week. This and other funding requirements will be discussed at that time.
	It was agreed that there is a need to get a sense of whether the renewable energy projected costs have increased since feasibility study was undertaken. It was agreed Council should seek clarification from Evan Dunn as to whether EDF11 has been signed off so partners can all work together to get the project underway expediently
