23 January - Bounty Day

Easter Monday

25 April - ANZAC Day

First Monday in June – Queen’s Birthday

3 July - Pitcairn Day (Discovery of Pitcairn) *cancelled*

2 July - Pitcairn Day (Discovery of Pitcairn) *date corrected*

11 November - Remembrance Day

25 December - Christmas Day

26 December - Day after Christmas (Boxing Day)
